Minor in Sanskrit Studies

Admission to the minor shall be declared no later than the first semester of the graduating year. Students should prepare a statement of objectives to attach to the application.

The undergraduate minor in Sanskrit Studies is intended for Cornell students who wish to broaden and deepen their competence in the Sanskrit language and traditional Indian religious, literary, and philosophical culture.

To complete the Sanskrit Studies Minor, students must:

1. Demonstrate language proficiency by completing SANSK 2251 (Intermediate Sanskrit I) or any higher-level Sanskrit course.
2. Take a minimum of five Sanskrit or Sanskrit-related courses, including at least one 3000-level or higher-level course, and totaling no fewer than 18 credits.
3. Courses which may be used to satisfy the Sanskrit Studies minor include (but additional courses may be accepted in consultation with the minor advisor):

4. A minimum grade of B- must be received for all courses counted towards the minor. S/U courses are ineligible.

Those enrolled in the Sanskrit Studies Minor are considered members of the South Asia Program and are encouraged to participate in all program activities.

The first step in applying for the Sanskrit Studies Minor is to consult with at least one of the eligible advising faculty: Professors Lawrence McCrea (ljm223), Daniel Boucher (djb38), or Daniel Gold (drg4). To apply, select an advisor from this list. Next, schedule an appointment with the Director of Undergraduate Studies, (asianstudiesdus@cornell.edu). Bring the completed application form to this appointment **along with a copy of your current Cornell transcript**; informal transcripts are accepted.

Once approved, return the form to the Asian Studies Department Office, 350 Rockefeller Hall.
